Our Vision

Our Mission

To eradicate vaccine-preventable diseases by educating the community, advocating evidence-based public policy and promoting immunization best practices.



Reminder/Recall

Reminder/recall is one of the most important immunization *best practices*.

Reminder/recall is recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

This project focuses on **recall** systems which track missed appointments during which immunizations would have been given.



The Setting

- One of the largest cities in US: 6 million in 12 county metropolitan region
- Transient, highly mobile patient base
- Large low-income population
- Highly diverse ethnic population
- Nearly 570 VFC-enrolled provider offices
- Lack of medical homes
- 3 public health departments



Barriers to Achieving High Immunization Rates

- Scarcity of VPD trainings by public health
- Inconsistent recording of administered doses into ImmTrac
- Continual turn-over of provider staff
- Unfamiliarity with ACIP vaccine schedules
- Inexperience with ImmTrac, Texas's IIS
- Lack of effective reminder/recall systems
- Many children receive shots from multiple providers



Project Objectives

- 1. Implement effective recall systems in healthcare clinics to increase and sustain immunization coverage rates.
- Mentor future healthcare professionals to become Immunization Champions.



Project Design

1. Identify potential clinics for project

Qualities for a successful clinic:

- ✓ Desire to increase immunization rates & understand value of recall to clinic
- ✓ Immunization Champion on staff
- ✓ Senior clinical & management staff "on board"
- ✓ Active ImmTrac user/electronic upload preferable



Project Design

- 2. Every project is customized & developed according to clinic's immunization needs:
 - **✓ Pediatric**
 - ✓ Adolescent
 - **✓** Adult
 - √ Vaccine or Disease specific



Clinic Assessment

- Using the CDC's Co-CASA tool, the targeted clinic cohort is audited to determine baseline coverage rate.
- Post-project audit is conducted to determine project outcome.
- Audit is conducted by a third-party contractor.



The Making of a Champion

Passion for Healthcare Ability to adapt to an established clinic Attention to Detail:

Screening multiple shot records

Deciphering faded & nearly illegible dates













Training

- Cross-train existing clinic staffer while training Immunization Champion to assure sustainability of recall process
- Provide Resource Manual
- Train on Immunization Schedules and ImmTrac



Ready, Set, Go...

- Populate recall spreadsheet with targeted patients
- 2. Screen records: Paper, electronic, ImmTrac
- 3. List missing shots on spreadsheet
- 4. Approval needed by supervisor
- 5. Contact parents/guardians/patients to return to clinic or submit shot record
- 6. Track returning patients' shots received
- **7. Report** metrics to T.I.P.





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Outcomes

Sustainable recall systems implemented: 14

Immunization Champions trained: 12

To date:

30,808+ records reviewed

3,986+ patients recalled

4,084+ patients added to ImmTrac
